MULVANE CITY COUNCIL REGULAR MEETING MINUTES

October 20, 2025 6:00 p.m.

The Mulvane City Council convened at the City Building at 211 N. Second at 6:00 p.m. Presiding was Mayor, Brent Allen, who called the meeting to order.

APPROVAL OF REGULAR MEETING MINUTES:

OLD BUSINESS

1. CDBG Funding for ADA Project:

Crystal Hinnen, with Ranson Financial, reviewed this item with the council. Professional Engineering Consultants (PEC) has completed a Preliminary Engineering Report (PER), for participating businesses, which includes documentation of the existing condition of the entryways with an overall plan to improve the sidewalk, entryways, and accessibility to make the entryways ADA compliant.

On September 15, 2025, the City Council approved sponsorship of the CDBG application and set the public hearing date for October 6th. CDBG had questions regarding the cost estimate of the project. To allow time for the questions to be addressed, and due to publication deadlines, the City Council rescheduled the public hearing to October 27th.

Ranson Financial has provided the application paperwork and resolutions for council's review and consideration. The City Attorney drafted the Sub-Applicant Agreement which will be approved for each business owner.

Mayor Allen asked for clarification regarding the project. Hinnen explained the application and resolutions. The Agreement will be between the City and business owners. If needed, the Mulvane Community Foundation plans to help raise funds for the business owners to meet their 10% match. The businesses that are ready to proceed have been moved to Phase 1 of the project and will need to provide a notice of funds. The City will only be the pass-through for the funds and will not pay for any improvements. Hinnen pointed out that not all businesses would qualify for grant funding since only low to moderate income individuals may apply. City Attorney, J.T. Klaus, asked if any buildings had anyone living in them, due to the HUD requirements referenced in the paperwork.

MOTION by Huntley, second by Gerber to approve Resolution No. 2025-9 certifying legal authority to apply to CDBG and authorize the Mayor to sign and submit such application. MOTION approved unanimously.

1. Project Review and Update:

<u>Main "A" Sanitary Sewer Improvements Phase 3</u> – Contractor is completing punch-list items. Waiting on final pay application.

<u>Main "A" Sanitary Sewer Improvements Phase 4</u> – Traffic control plans for Charles St. were prepared and sent to the City. Traffic on W. Charles will be limited to one-way southbound from Martha to Franklin and is scheduled to begin approximately 10/31/25.

Cities and Counties are the only ones who can apply for CDBG. Mulvane Foundation has requested the city partner with them on this application. Public hearing was held October 27. Application paper work has been signed.

RE: Employee Health Insurance Program

Action: 2026 Employee Benefit Plan/Package with Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Kansas

Background:

There are currently sixty-nine (69) employees with a total of approximately 187 members insured on the city's medical plan. The city currently pays 92% of the medical plan for all employees. The city contributes \$1,000 for singles and \$1,500 for employees with dependents on the medical plan, into a Health Reimbursement Account. The City budgeted for a 15% increase in health insurance premiums for 2026. The Dept. Heads comprise the health and safety committee. The committee discussed the benefit consultants research and recommendations.

Facts:

- The city renewed with Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Kansas effective January 1, 2025, with a 8.4% decrease, which was below the city's budget increase of 15%. If the city renewed 2025 with Blue Cross Blue Shield under a partially self-funded contract, the rate adjustment would have been 12.8%, however the city renewed with Blue Cross Blue Shield under a fully insured contract and saved 8.4% with a decrease compared to 2024 rates.
- In 2024, the city renewed with Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Kansas, moving from fully insured to partially self-funded, saving the city a 9.9% decrease, as opposed to the fully insured renewal offered by Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Kansas.
- In 2023, the city renewed with a fully insured plan through Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Kansas, resulting in a 3.9% increase.
- Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Kansas develops rates for fully insured plans differently than partially self-funded plans. Part of the rating method includes Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Kansas using the past 32 months of claims to develop partially self-funded rates, and only 12 months of claims to develop fully insured rates. Therefore, some years the rating may be financially advantageous to be partially self-funded, whereas other years fully insured rates may net out lower.
- Blue Cross Blue Shield is offering a 5.7% renewal for 2026 under the fully insured plan and will
 not offer the city a partially self-funded option. BCBS indicated the partially self-funded option
 would be close to the 2025 renewal, or a 15.5% increase compared to current rates when
 adjusting to 2026.

- The Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Kansas 2026 fully insured renewal option mirrors the 2025 current employee out-of-pocket benefits and are below the city's budget increase of 15%.
- The average 2026 renewals are approximately 9.5% increases, and in Kansas, the mode is in the 20% range for rate increases.
- In addition to Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Kansas, the unbundled option of Allied as the TPA, ProviDRsCare or Aetna as the network, Oread as the Pharmacy Benefit Manager may be a competitive option. However, this option has not yet been received, thus the competitiveness of this unbundled plan is yet to be known. Alternatively, we've reviewed Trustmark, which requires individual medical questionnaires, Gravie and Marpai. The rate proposed rates from Gravie and Marpai are very similar to the renewal rates offered by Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Kansas. The following carriers declined to provide a quote: UnitedHealthcare (fully insured and partially self-funded), and Allstate (partially self-funded). Aetna continues to have little market share in our area and is still considered to have poor service reviews.

Renewal Updates for 2026:

BCBS Medical (Fully Insured) +5.7% increase (92/8 split)

Delta Dental of Kansas +2.74% increase (92/8 split)

Surency Vision – Rate Guarantee until 1/1/2027 (Employee Paid)

Surency FSA/HRA – Rate Guarantee until 1/1/2028 – Administrative fee \$3.85 pppm FSA & HRA (City contributes \$1,000 for single & \$1,500 for employee/dependent into HRA)

Mutual of Omaha (Life, STD, AD&D) – Rate Guarantee until 1/1/2027 (City paid)

Unum Long Term Care: No longer available for new enrollments – Looking at other options.

(City pays for \$1,000/mo. coverage for a benefit duration of 3 years for LTC coverage)

EMPAC EAP - \$2.90 pepm increase to \$3.20 pepm

Analysis:

Staff and the consultant recommend approving the fully insured renewal contract with Blue Cross Blue Shield for medical coverage, Delta Dental for dental coverage, Surency for vision coverage and FSA/HRA Administration, Mutual of Omaha for Life, STD, AD&D, and EMPAC Employee Assistance Program effective January 1, 2026. Staff is waiting on information for Long Term Care (LTC).

Financial Considerations:

Annualized Premiums

Dental – The dental plan rates with Delta Dental are increasing by 2.74% - \$2,611.08 (92/8 split) **Vision** - The vision plan rates with Surency are not increasing and will remain flat. (Employee paid)

Legal Considerations:

As per city attorney.

Timeframe for decision:

In the past, the council wanted more time to review health insurance proposals. This council meeting and the 11/17/2025 meeting are the two opportunities to review and discuss this issue.

To prepare and present 2026 benefit information to employees at enrollment meetings during the week after Thanksgiving, update enrollment, and get any ID cards distributed as needed before the start of the new plan year, it would be better to have a council decision sooner rather than later.

Recommendations:

City staff along with USI, are recommending that the city renew the employee health insurance plan with Blue Cross Blue Shield (Fully Insured), Delta Dental for dental coverage, Surency for vision coverage and FSA/HRA Administration, Long Term Care (provider to be determined), EMPAC for Employee Assistance Program, and Mutual of Omaha for Life, AD&D, and Short-Term Disability effective January 1, 2026. All other coverages are paid for by the employee.

AGENDA: Purchase of Sodium Hydroxide and Ferric Chloride from Brenntag

Background: In 2011 the city started a sewer expansion project to accommodate the addition of the Kansas Star Casino. This expansion included two chemical injection sites, one located at the casino site, and the other located at the wastewater plant site. These chemical injection buildings hold two 4500-gallon tanks, one will contain ferric chloride and the other sodium hydroxide. At the casino site, by use of chemical metering pumps, the chemicals are injected directly into the force main, and at the plant site the chemicals are injected into the process. The biggest use for these chemicals is odor control and managing PH, however better settling at the plant is also a benefit from the ferric chloride.

Due to the scarce availability of supplies and the increase cost of transportation, the price of these chemicals has increased substantially.

After obtaining approval from the City Administrator to place this purchase on the consent agenda, ordered the chemicals at a cost of \$38,000.00. This would purchase one load of caustic soda and one load of ferric chloride to be split between the two sites.

Legal Considerations: Per City Attorney.

Financial Considerations: Funds for this expenditure are available in the Wastewater Department budget.

Recommendations/Action: A motion to approve the purchase of 45,000 lbs. of ferric chloride for \$19,000.00 and 45,000 lbs. of sodium hydroxide for \$19,000.00 at a total cost of \$38,000.00. This price includes insurance surcharge and fuel cost. Load may vary slightly but is charged by the pounds delivered.
